Modern fastcore's blackest cult ascends once more from its knighted abyss to deliver thirty-one hymns of infernal savagery. Only for true devotees to the Esoteric Order of Sonic Blasphemy. Twenty-seven minutes of music and forty minutes of enhanced material included on the CD when inserted into a PC or a Mac. Full color digipack. FFO *NEOS*, *LARM*, and fastcore.

Assholeparade - Live in Rostock 10" (TLAL45)



Twenty-one tracks of raw seething hardcore of one of the greatest sets from one of the greatest fast hardcore bands. Pro-recorded live from the soundboard in Germany and professionally mastered. Gold foil printed cover, this is quite a deluxe release. Record is on its second pressing. Band has many releases of *NO IDEA RECORDS*.

Magnum Force - Self-Loathing 7" (TLAL46)



This record rages as hard if not harder than any Clint Eastwood vigilante film you've ever seen. Hell, it rages harder than any of Charles Bronson's Deathwish movies. This has more breakdowns than any Mad Max movie. It may even be the Taxi Driver of grindcore. Eight songs of ear crumping grindviolence from Arizona. For fans of the new era of grindcore/powerviolence, anything from *MAGRUDERGRIND*, *INSECT WARFARE*, to *IN DISGUST*. Each copy comes with a DIY digital download code so you can listen to a 320mhz MP3 of the record.

Finally here and in its full glory. The final testament of Miami's crusted grindcore powerhouse syndicate. Features members the singer from *SHITSTORM*, *TORCHE* and members of *HARDWARE YOUTH* and was recorded by Jon Nunez of *TORCHE/SHITSTORM* fame. Long live 305 grindcore. Album comes with a download code for full art and 320KBPS MP3s of the record.

V/A - To Live A Lie 7" (TLAL50) **BRAND NEW**



Having taken around two years to come out, the wait was well worth it. Packed full of grindcore, this 7" is stunning, and comes with a bronze colored cover. Definitely worthy of the TLAL name. Featuring... *MIND AS PRISON*, *MATKA TERESA*,

DISCIPLES OF CHRIST (mem of *MAGRUDERGRIND/COKE BUST*), *THE KILL*, *OLD PAINLESS*, *TOTAL FUCKING DESTRUCITON*, *ARCHAGATHUS*, *FUBAR*, *BUD SPENCER* (mem of *LOOKING FOR AN ANSWER*), *WORLDS*, *SPOONFUL OF VICODIN*, and *MAGRUDERGRIND*.

Suffering Luna - s/t LP (TLAL51) **BRAND NEW**



These are the recordings that pushed hardcore music farther than ever into L.A.'s anxiety ridden, misanthropic inner city world of psychedelics and hard drugs. First new release in a decade. Band had splits with *GASP* and with *DYSTOPIA* in the 90's.

Sissy Spacek - Vanishing Point 7" (TLAL53)



Noise god John Wiese is back with his cohorts to pummel your ears with nonsensical noise-grind. Six songs in a minute and a half. John Wiese is known for working with *SUN O)))* and *BASTARD NOISE*.

Sidetracked - Uniform 7" (TLAL57)



Tacoma, WA's Sidetracked unleash their finest work to date. Thirteen songs of chaotic fastcore/powerviolence reminiscent of bands like *NO COMMENT*, *LACK OF INTEREST*, and *CAPITALIST*

CASUALTIES. One sided 7inch, comes with digital download. Comes with a DIY digital download card where you can get the art and 320kbps MP3s of the whole album.

Deathrats - Give Up 7" (TLAL55)



Following a highly praised self titled release, their sophomore release brings forth even more introspective/angry lyrics, more intensely angular blasting hardcore and delivers an overall scathing sound. Female fronted DC hardcore not for the weak-hearted. All copies come with a digital download card so you can easily jam the record and grab the download for your MP3 player to go. FFO *PUNCH*, *BLANK STARE*, and feminist fast hardcore punk.

No Comply - One Sided 7" (TLAL58)



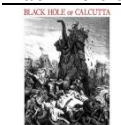
Reincarnation of Floridian NoComply. Drummachine powerviolence. NOTE to vendors, record has a technical skip in it that the band wanted to keep.

Sakatat / Mesrine - split 7" (TLAL59) **BRAND NEW**



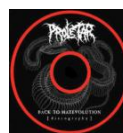

MESRINE's side has some of their classic tunes first time on vinyl while on the flipside, SAKATAT offer arguably their fiercest recordings ever! FFO *AGATHOCLES*, *DAHMER*, *ANb*, and grindcore.

Black Hole of Calcutta - s/t 7" (TLAL61) **BRAND NEW**



Crust/black metal influenced hardcore with some grind parts. Covers are on recycled material. Two long songs, excellent record.

TLAL16 - Proletar - Back to Hatevolution CD

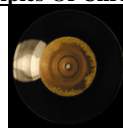
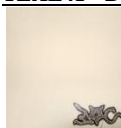
Brutal old school grindcore from Jakarta, Indonesia. This discography release spans from 2000 on, and contains more than fifty songs in over 70 minutes from tape EPs, demos, their full length album, splits, and some unreleased, live, and cover songs. Repress out now.

TLAL38 - Conga Fury / Shitstorm - split 7"



CONGA FURY and SHITSTORM were never meant to be paired up. Forces were against this unstable match-up as masters were lost between Japan and the USA thrice over a span of over two years, delays in recording, and the plates shattering while making test presses of this beast. Finally this release comes to fruition with a horrifyingly explosive energy as C-Beat meets G-Beat. Japan's CONGA FURY, masters of Kochi City hardcore, team up with Miami's connoisseurs of super-blasting grindviolence, SHITSTORM, to shake up the musical malaise that has infested both Japan and America. A monsoon of fury on one slab of vinyl.
